



## Low Voltage Rescue

The objective of this training program is to provide guidelines for a worker to perform the safe rescue of a victim who has received an electric shock or personal injuries while working on low voltage conductors or equipment.

All students will be required to show working knowledge of low voltage electrical rescue techniques along with CPR and relevant first aid
